competition categories: KATA: * student class mix
* master class mix
KUMITE: * Team (each of two fighters)
* BÔ-SHIAI
(If there are not enough participants in a group, it can be put together with another one.)

rules: Basically the competition rules of the Ryûkyû Kobudô Teshshinkan Kyô Kai - Europe are applied!

⇒ **KATA:**

The competitors may repeat Kata. Two Kata are enough to know, but they have to be shown in an alternating order.
Nunchaku-Kata are not allowed!
Tekkô-Kata must be demonstrated with Tekkô replacements.

⇒ **YAKUSOKU-KUMITE (Team):**

Two teams demonstrate successively 6 combinations from BÔ-NO-KIHON BUNKAI (1st round) and BÔ-TAI-SAI (2nd round) / KUMITE Mode E.
It does not matter in which order the BUNKAI are demonstrated.
If single BUNKAI are combined to a series, some intermediate movements may be built in.

⇒ **BÔ-SHIAI:**

For Kyû-levels: Competing in Bô-Shiai is only allowed for those who compete in Yakusoku-Kumite as well.

competitor registration: The registration period will end on 31st May 2018.

Ryûkyû Kobudô

Ryûkyû is the name of an island chain in the south-west of Japan. Its most important island is Okinawa which belongs to Japan today.

In former times the inhabitants of these islands often had to fight against the encroachments of pirates and occupying forces from Japan. That is why they also used everyday objects as weapons. The fighting techniques developed this way are closely connected with modern Karate and are called Kôbu-Jutsu.

Nowadays the practising of these fighting techniques serves the perfection of the character of the trainees and is called Kôbu-Dô.

Ryûkyû Kobudô Teshshinkan

The association "Ryûkyû Kobudô Teshshinkan Kyôkai" was founded by Tamayose Sensei on May 22nd, 1999. The Honbu-Dôjô is in Ozato on Okinawa. Twenty-three Kata have been handed down by Taira Shinken through Akamine Eisuke to Tamayose Hidemi, which are taught in the association of Teshshinkan nowadays.

Tamayose Hidemi who is one of the most high-ranking students of the late Akamine Eisuke, the former 2nd president of Ryûkyû Kobudô Hozon Shinkô Kai, wants to keep and continue the Ryûkyû Kobudô in his master's tradition.

Ryûkyû Shôrin-Ryû Karate-Dô Teshshinkan

Tamayose Sensei teaches Kobayashi Shôrin-Ryû additionally. This style of Okinawa-Karate being in the direct tradition of Itosu Yasutsune's Shuri-Te teaches a fundamental Karate which matches perfectly to Ryûkyû Kobudô regarding the techniques.
