Ryûkyû Kobudô

Ryûkyû is the name of an island chain in the south-west of Japan. Its most important island is Okinawa which belongs to Japan today.

In former times, the inhabitants of these islands often had to fight against the encroachments of pirates and occupying forces from Japan. Therefore, they made use of their everyday tools as weapons. The fighting techniques developed this way, are closely connected with modern Karate and are called Kobu-Jutsu.

Nowadays, the practice of these fighting techniques serves the development of one's character and is, thus, called Kobu-Dô.

Ryûkyû Kobudô Tesshinkan

The association "Ryûkyû Kobudô Tesshinkan Kyô Kai" was founded by Tamayose Sensei on May 22, 1999. The Honbu-Dôjô is located in Ozato, Okinawa. Twenty-three Kata have been handed down by Taira Shinken through Akamine Eisuke to Tamayose Hidemi, which comprise the curriculum of Tesshinkan nowadays.

Tamayose Hidemi being one of the highest-ranked students of the late Akamine Eisuke, the former second president of Ryûkyû Kobudô Hozon Shinkô Kai, is dedicated to keeping and continuing the Ryûkyû Kobudô in his master's tradition.

Ryûkyû Shôrin Ryû Karate Dô Tesshinkan

Tamayose Sensei teaches Kobayashi Ryû additionally. This style of Okinawa-Karate being in the direct tradition of Itosu Ankô's Shuri-Te teaches a fundamental Karate which fits perfectly to Ryûkyû Kobudô regarding the mechanics.
